Introduction

This policy works alongside our privacy policy, which you can find on our website (<http://www.data-discovery.co.za/>). The purpose of this policy is to describe what cookies are, what we use them for, and how you can manage them during your visit to or use of our website.

What are cookies?

We may place small text files called ‘cookies’ on your device when you visit our website. Cookies are small pieces of information that are sent to your browser and that are stored when you visit websites. Temporary or session cookies expire and are deleted when the browser is closed. Cookies by themselves cannot be used to personally identify a data subject and you can personally alter the manner in which your browser handles cookies. Many websites use cookies, and you can find out more about them at www.allaboutcookies.org.

Why do we use cookies?

These files serve a number of useful purposes for you, including:

- improving how our website performs;
- delivering interest-based advertising where appropriate in compliance with the applicable laws.

The types of cookies we use

We use different types of cookies on our website. These cookies may be deleted from your device at different times, such as at the end of your browsing session (when you leave the website) or after a pre-set amount time, or they may persist on your device until you delete them.

We use the following types of cookies on our website:

- **essential cookies** – these are cookies that allow our website to perform its essential functions. Without these cookies, some parts of our website would stop working.
- **site analytics cookies** – these are cookies that monitor how our website is performing, and how you interact with it. We use them to know how best to improve our website or services.

Our cookies

Our website uses cookies to run the website in various ways, such as providing essential services and site analytics. If you “Agree” to the pop-up notice, you consent to us using all cookies, including non-essential cookies. If you “Disagree” to the pop-up notice, you consent to us using essential cookies only (such as cookies needed for fonts).

Deleting cookies

Your internet browser generally accepts cookies automatically, but you can often change this setting to stop accepting them. You can also delete cookies manually. You can read how to do this at <https://www.digitaltrends.com/computing/how-to-delete-cookies/>.
